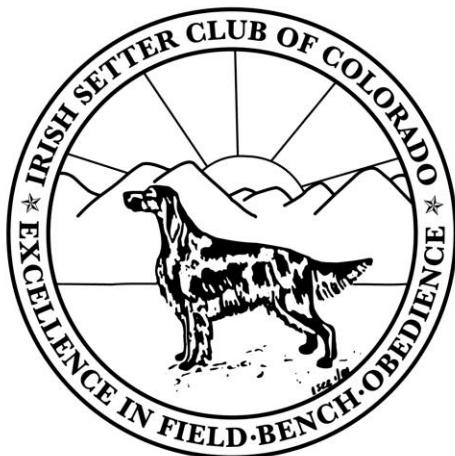

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES – INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

**Veteran Dog** : A class for Dogs seven (7) years or older.

**Veteran Bitch** : A class for Bitches seven (7) years or older.

**Note:** Chapter 11, Section 8 of the Dog Show Rules provides that castrated males may be entered in the Veteran Dog Class and spayed females may be entered in the Veteran Bitch Class at independent Specialties.

**Field Dog** - for dogs who have received a 1st – 4th placement at an AKC Field Trial, and / or hold one of the AKC Hunt Test titles (JH, SH, or MH).

**Field Bitch** - for bitches who have received a 1st – 4th placement at an AKC Field Trial, and / or hold one of the AKC Hunt Test titles (JH, SH, or MH).

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES – INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**Brace Class** - *Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. Dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of entry, full particulars must be given on an Official AKC Entry Form. Brace must be marked as an Additional Class.*

**Stud Dog Class** -- For Stud Dogs and two or more of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the stud dog class. The Get must be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

**Brood Bitch Class** -- Same as for Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

*As the judges decisions in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.*

**Judges Awards of Merit:** Awarded at the judge's discretion, the number of awards will be determined by the number of Best of Breed entries with one (1) Award of Merit offered for every five (5) entries with a maximum of 5 awards. BOB and BOS winner are not eligible for an Award of Merit.

**AKC Grand Champion Select Competition:** The Grand Champion Select Competition Class shall be for dogs that are Champions of Record competing in Best of Breed. This includes dogs transferred to Best of Breed which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. In addition, Champions that win Non-Regular Classes & become eligible for Best of Breed competition (altered or spayed Champion Veteran Class winners at independent specialties) are eligible. Winners Dog & Winners Bitch are not eligible for Grand Champion competition. At the judge's discretion, Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Grand Champion Competition will not continue beyond Best of Breed Competition.

**AKC National Owner-Handled Series:** The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers, and is conducted following the Best of Breed judging. All dogs that are owner-handled and are not owned, co-owned or exhibited by professional handlers meet the requirements for this competition. **Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog.** Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner.

**From the Irish Setter Club of America VC Program rules -**

**GUIDELINES FOR CONFORMATION VERSATILITY JUDGING (VC only)**

Versatility Conformation judging should be based on the present Standard which emphasizes the make and fit of all the parts and over-all balance. You are not attempting to determine whether the dog is of championship caliber in conformation but whether the specimen reflects the qualities of a pure-bred Irish Setter. A Versatility Pass should be withheld only if you would withhold a ribbon at a regular AKC Breed Show. Dogs will be presented in a condition that will allow for the adequate evaluation of coat, color, structure and movement. Three (3) passes under three (3) different judges are required.

The judging will be guided by the following scale of points:

Head .....	20
Body .....	20
Running Gear .....	30
Coat .....	5
Size, Temperament, and General Appearance .....	25

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
